The purpose of a centralized reporter is to have all reports of dead deer reported to the same State or County Agency so there is no confusion as to the total number of struck deer. This makes it easier to get deer warning signs, and possibly deer reflectors, along OCR.

THE RIDGE AT OLD COURT ROAD DEVELOPMENT UPDATE

The Ridge at Old Court Road is a proposed development zoned DR 1 on 8 acres at 2801 Old Court Road (OCR), just east of Springbriar Lane. The developer, Five M LLC, previously proposed to remove the existing house and build 7 single-family houses. Now the developer has proposed 6 large houses on just 4 acres. The remaining 4 acres are unbuildable or will be a storm water management area, eventually to be the responsibility of the home owners since Baltimore County has declined ownership. A Community Input Meeting (CIM) was held on November 5, 2009 at the Pikesville High School and was attended by over 50 concerned neighbors. A number of issues pertaining to the property were raised at the CIM, and there was strong opposition to the existing development plan. Old Court Road is listed as a Maryland State Scenic Byway, and we wish to keep it as close as possible to its current view from the road. The property at 2801 OCR contains steep slopes and streams, and it currently has storm water runoff problems affecting contiguous properties.

There were two Development Review Committee (DRC) meetings in 2010, and a Hearing Officer's Hearing (HOH) was held on Feb. 24, 2011. The county approved the development of 6 houses as requested even though we believe that county agencies did not properly consider the drainage problems, especially for those properties on Springbriar and within Greenspring East as well as the steep incline of the slopes. The scenic designation for OCR was ignored. An appeal of the decision was requested by OCGS and took place on Nov. 10, 2011.

A final Appeal Board deliberation, open to the public, will be held on Jan. 18, 2012, Room 206, Jefferson Building, 105 West Chesapeake Ave., Towson, MD 21204. An appeal decision will be issued after the deliberation. We are asking that OCGS residents attend and listen to the deliberation on January 18th. A strong neighborhood turn-out indicates to the Appeal Judges that our residents want the current development plan to be denied. Please support OCGS and attend this meeting.
